



**AN ACT TO AMEND § 80113(b) OF CHAPTER 80,
DIVISION 4, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR ALLIED HEALTH
PROVIDERS EMPLOYED AS HEALTH CARE
ADMINISTRATORS (HCA) AT THE GUAM
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY TO BE
MEMBERS OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Subsection (b) of § 80113, Chapter 80 of Division 4, Title 10,
3 Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

4 “(b) All employees of the hospital, *except* physicians and healthcare
5 administrators, the Hospital Administrator, Associate Administrators for

1 Clinical, Operations and Medical Services, and the Chief Financial Officer,
2 *shall* be members of the classified service of the government of Guam.

3 (1) This Subsection *shall* include Allied Health providers, as
4 defined pursuant to Chapter 12, Part 1 and Part 2, of Title 10, Guam
5 Code Annotated, practicing in their specialty and employed as Health
6 Care Administrators (HCA) for their department who *shall* be
7 members of the classified service of the government of Guam. These
8 positions are herein referenced, but not limited to, as follows: Chief
9 Respiratory Therapist (HCA), Chief Hospital Radiology Technologist
10 (HCA), Chief Hospital Pharmacist (HCA), Administrator of
11 Laboratory Services (HCA), Chief of Rehabilitative Services (HCA),
12 and Administrator of Hospital Food Services (HCA).”

13 **Section 2. Classification Without Loss or Reduction in Salary, Status**
14 **or Benefits.** As provided pursuant to Section 1 of this Act, and notwithstanding
15 any provision of law, rule, or regulation, the personnel in the positions identified in
16 Item (1) of § 80113(b) of Chapter 80 of Division 4, Title 10, Guam Code
17 Annotated, *shall* have their admission as members in the classified service of the
18 government of Guam occur without a disruption in service, or loss or reduction in
19 salary, status or benefits.

20 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
21 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
22 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
23 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
24 provisions of this Act are severable.

25 **Section 4. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Act *shall* become
26 effective upon enactment.
