

**AN ACT TO AMEND § 8114.1 OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 7,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
AUTHORIZING GOVERNMENT OF GUAM
EMPLOYEES TO JOIN THE VOLUNTEER DEPUTY
MARSHAL RESERVE PROGRAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Intent.** It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to
3 remove the prohibition restricting full-time government of Guam employees from
4 joining the Volunteer Deputy Marshal Reserve Program, so that government of
5 Guam employees may be considered for selection.

6 **Section 2. Enhancement of the Volunteer Deputy Marshal Reserve**
7 **Program.** § 8114.1 of Chapter 8, Title 7, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
8 *amended* to read:

9 “§ 8114.1. **Eligibility and Recruitment.** A volunteer must be
10 qualified as a Superior Court of Guam Deputy Marshal, and have graduated
11 from the Guam Police Academy, the Basic Law Enforcement Academy, or a
12 qualified law enforcement academic program within Guam.

13 Volunteers *shall* be recruited from within this qualified category of
14 eligible candidates.”
