**AN ACT TO AMEND § 77302 OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 77, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE DUTIES OF THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY ASSISTED POLICING EFFORT (CAPE) VOLUNTEERS TO INCLUDE THE 12<sup>TH</sup> FESTIVAL OF PACIFIC ARTS (FESTPAC).**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.**    § 77302 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended*  
3 to read as follows:

4            “§ 77302.    **Volunteers.**    Pursuant to § 3401.1(h) of Article 4,  
5 Chapter 3 of Title 16 Guam Code Annotated, the Chief of Police is  
6 authorized to recruit volunteers to assist the Guam Police Department in the

1 enforcement of the accessible parking and littering laws. In addition to these  
2 duties, the Chief of Police shall authorize the use of volunteers to patrol the  
3 school campuses of the Guam Department of Education during non-school  
4 hours. The volunteers shall take no enforcement action during their patrol of  
5 the school campuses, and shall notify the police of suspicious activity or  
6 crimes in progress. The Superintendent of Education shall cooperate with the  
7 Chief of Police to implement this Section.

8 The Chief of Police is further authorized to recruit volunteers to assist  
9 the Guam Police Department with traffic direction, security, and crowd  
10 control for events such as, but not limited to, the Guam Ko'ko Road Race,  
11 the Guam-Micronesia Island Fair, the Liberation Day Parade, and the 12<sup>th</sup>  
12 Festival of Pacific Arts (FestPac), in which the specific tasks will be  
13 coordinated with the 12<sup>th</sup>FestPac Security Committee. Volunteers may only  
14 assist the Guam Police Department if they have previously obtained a  
15 certificate from the Chief of Police demonstrating the successful completion  
16 of a required course of instruction and training that includes training relative  
17 to traffic direction, security, and crowd control.”
