**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §4309 TO ARTICLE 3 OF CHAPTER
4 OF 4GCA RELATIVE TO JOB SITE PREFERENCE.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslatura* finds that the Government of Guam must do what it can to ease the growing burden of increasing gasoline prices on its employees. Many GovGuam employees who work for agencies that have multiple job sites are assigned to the site farthest from their homes. While *I Liheslatura* is aware that this is sometimes necessary, it also sees the need to mandate that, to the extent possible, employees will be assigned to a job site close to their homes or to that of their spouses in order to promote car pooling and reduce energy costs.

Section 2. A new Section 4309 is added to Article 3 of Chapter 4 of 4GCA to read as follows:

“§4309. Job Site Preference. To the extent possible, practical and without adversely affecting the operations of an agency, all Government of Guam departments, agencies, instrumentalities, public corporations and commissions with more than one job site shall, if requested by an employee, assign such employee to the job site closest to the employee’s residence, or in the alternative, to the place of employment of the employee’s spouse. In the event that there are more requests than positions available for a job-site transfer(s), preference for such transfer(s) shall be based on job seniority.”
