AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE I MAGA'LAHI, THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM, TO TRANSFER UP TO 80% OF ALL SURPLUS FUNDS HELD BY THE **GUAM** HOUSING CORPORATION. DETERMINED JOINTLY BY THE DIRECTOR OF AND **TAXATION** REVENUE AND **PRESIDENT** THE **OF GUAM** HOUSING CORPORATION, FROM THE GUAM HOUSING CORPORATION TO THE **DEPARTMENT** REVENUE AND TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING INCOME TAX REFUNDS.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
- 3 finds that the Office of the Public Auditor (OPA) has determined that the
- 4 Guam Housing Corporation (GHC) has a surplus in excess of \$12 Million,
- 5 and that the Government of Guam can utilize unobligated GHC funds to
- 6 pay for other GovGuam debts. According to the OPA, such surplus was
- 7 made possible because, in August of 2002, Public Law 26-123 forgave GHC
- 8 debt to the General fund comprised of \$13,650,013 plus accrued interest of
- 9 \$517,000.
- It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* that the President of
- 11 the GHC and the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation (Rev

- 1 & Tax) jointly determine the exact amount of surplus funds controlled by
- 2 the GHC, and that the GHC President and the Rev & Tax Director
- 3 immediately shall transmit such information to *I Maga'lahi* and *I Liheslatura*.
- 4 I Maga'lahi shall make Eighty Percent (80%) of such sums agreed upon by
- 5 the GHC and Rev & Tax available to be paid out to taxpayers awaiting
- 6 income tax refunds. It is the additional intent of *I Liheslatura* that Twenty
- 7 Percent (20%) of the funds shall remain with GHC.
- 8 **Section 2. Authorization for transfer.** Notwithstanding any other
- 9 provision of law, up to Eighty Percent (80%) of such sums held by the
- 10 Guam Housing Corporation (GHC), as has been determined by the
- 11 President of the GHC and the Director of the Department of Revenue and
- 12 Taxation (Rev & Tax) to be in excess of the needs and obligations of the
- 13 GHC, pursuant to the requirements of Section 3 of this Act, are hereby
- authorized to be transferred by I Maga'Lahi from GHC to Rev & Tax for the
- sole purpose of paying income tax refunds. Such transferred funds shall be
- 16 completely paid out by October 1, 2009.
- 17 Section 3. Sworn Affidavit. Upon determination and agreement of
- 18 the total amount of funds in excess of the needs and obligations of the
- 19 Guam Housing Corporation, the President of GHC and Director of Rev &
- 20 Tax shall transmit a signed, sworn affidavit reflecting the same to I
- 21 Maga'lahen Guåhan, to the Speaker of I Liheslatura, to the Attorney General
- 22 of Guam, to the Public Auditor, to the Director of the Department of

- 1 Administration, and to the Director of the Bureau of Budget and
- 2 Management Research.
- 3 **Section 4. Reporting of transfer.** *I Maga'Lahi* shall notify the Speaker

4 of *I Liheslatura* within five (5) working days of such transfer.
