AN ACT TO AMEND § 15A301 OF CHAPTER 15, TITLE 17 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO LIMITATIONS ON ENTITLEMENTS TO MERIT AWARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. § 15A301. Students Entitled to Merit Awards. § 15A301
- of Chapter 15, Title 17 is hereby *amended* to read:
- 4 "(i) United States citizens, or a permanent resident alien, who
- 5 has completed a minimum of three (3) years, but no more than four (4)
- 6 academic years and meets all academic credit requirements for graduation
- 7 during attendance in a public, non-public, or DODEA or Catholic, Christian,
- 8 or private secular high school on Guam."
