AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVIDING NECESSARY FUNDING FOR THE BALANCE OF THE FISCAL YEAR TO CRITICAL YOUTH SUPPORT PROGRAMS; TO INCLUDE THE DMHSA YOUTH DRUG AND ALCOHOL PROGRAMS, AND THE PROGRAMS FOR YOUTHS WHO ARE RUNAWAYS, HOMELESS OR VICTIMS OF ABUSE; THROUGH AMENDING EXISTING PROVISIONS OF LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislature Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan 1 finds that the funds appropriated in the fiscal year 2009 budget in support 2 of vital youth development and support programs dealing with drug and 3 alcohol abuse, runaways, homeless or victims of abuse, have been 4 identified by the respective service providers as being limited and 5 insufficient to continue the administration of existing support programs at 6 its present level without the need for additional financial support. 7 ILiheslaturan Guåhan further finds that these programs presently being 8 provided in support of our youths have proven to be extremely successful 9 and necessary in providing Guam's youths, who are being assisted through 10

these programs, with the direct and necessary support to become positive,
contributing members of our community.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide, at a minimum, the funding necessary to sustain existing operations and support for these critical youth support programs for the balance of fiscal year 2009. This provision would increase the initial appropriation figures, and grant budgetary flexibility for the government of Guam to finance these essential programs.

9 Section 2. Sustainable Financial Support to Guam's Critical Youth
10 Development and Support Programs for Balance of Fiscal Year 2009. The
11 following provisions contained in Public Law No. 29-113, Section 31 and
12 Section 37 are hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"Section 31. DMHSA Youth Drug and Alcohol Program. Of 13 the sum appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and 14 Substance Abuse from the General Fund for operations in 1(x) Part I 15 of Chapter V of this act, the amount of (\$141,582) \$216,582 shall be 16 used to fund the Youth Drug and Alcohol Program. I Maga'lahen 17 Guåhan may exercise his transfer authority as provided for in the 18 Fiscal Year 2009 Budget to implement the appropriations provided 19 herein." 20

21 "Section 37. Youth Program Appropriation. The sum of Three
22 Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars
23 (\$371,677) Five Hundred Seventy-one Thousand Six Hundred

Seventy-seven Dollars (\$571,677.00) is appropriated from the
General Fund to the Department of Youth Affairs for Sanctuary, Inc.
in Fiscal Year 2009 to fund programs for youths who are runaways,
homeless *or* victims of abuse. I Maga'lahen Guåhan may exercise
<u>his transfer authority as provided for in Fiscal Year 2009 Budget to</u>
implement the appropriations provided herein."

Section 3. The following provision contained in Public Law No. 2952, Section 9 is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"Section 9. The Department of Youth Affairs (DYA) is 9 authorized to pay prior years' obligations, including obligations to 10 (One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars 11 Sanctuary, Inc. \$130,000.00), from the appropriations made to DYA in Public Law 29-12 19. I Maga'lahen Guåhan may exercise his transfer authority as 13 provided for in the Fiscal Year 2009 Budget to implement the 14 appropriations provided herein." 15
