REQUIRE THE APPROVAL ACT TO LIHESLATURA OF ANY CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN ANY BRANCH OR AGENCY OF THE UNITED **STATES MILITARY** DEPARTMENT **OF** FEDERAL-CONTRACTOR DEFENSE AND ANY AGENCY OR **INSTRUMENTALITY** OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM REGARDING ACCESS TO THE **ISLANDS** WASTE-WATER **SYSTEMS** AND FACILITIES BY ENACTING A NEW § 14104.3 OF 12 GCA

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- that the People of Guam should not be saddled with the burden created by the
- 4 Island's growing military population. I Liheslatura further finds that the
- 5 People of Guam should fully benefit from any arrangement between the
- 6 United States Military and certain agencies and/or regulatory bodies which
- 7 will allow for the United States military, Department of Defense or Federal-
- 8 Contractor to utilize the Island's waste-water systems. It is therefore the
- 9 intent of I Liheslatura to enact a new § 14104.3 of 12 GCA to require the

- oversight of I Liheslatura over any contractual arrangement as described
- 2 above.
- 3 Section 2. A new § 14104.3 of 12 GCA is hereby enacted to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 § 14104.3. Required Approval.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any contract to be entered 6 into by the Guam Waterworks Authority, Consolidated Commission on 7 Utilities, or any other Agency or Instrumentality of the Government of Guam 8 including Boards and Commissions, which allows for the use of any 9 component of the Government of Guam's waste water systems or facilities by 10 any agency or branch of the United States Military, the Department of 11 Defense, the United States Federal Government, or any Federal contractor or 12 Sub-Contractor contracted to manage waste water services for facilities 13 owned by any of the above, shall require the majority approval of I14 Liheslatura. Any contract entered into against this provision of law shall be 15 hereby invalid and not enforceable by any agency or instrumentality of the 16 Government of Guam. 17
