AN ACT TO REPROGRAM FUNDS FROM THE GUAM HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE GUAM VETERANS CEMETERY, AND TO REPROGRAM FUNDS WITHIN THE GUAM VETERANS AFFAIRS FISCAL YEAR 2010 OPERATIONAL BUDGET

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that P.L. 30-9,
- 3 signed into law during Fiscal Year 2009, appropriated Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 4 (\$200,000) from the Guam Highway Fund for the operations and maintenance of the Guam
- 5 Veterans Cemetery but only 25% of said funds were expended or encumbered by the end of the
- 6 FY'09. The appropriation account was established as an annual account, with the balance
- 7 reverted back to the Guam Highway Fund after FY '09, and
- 8 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds the Guam Veterans Affairs Office has expended funds
- 9 appropriated by P.L. 30-9 to purchase a vehicle in FY '09, and that funds appropriated in the
- 10 FY'10 (PL 30-55) for the purchase of another vehicle should be reprogrammed, and

1	I Liheslaturan Guahan finds the Guam Veterans Affairs Office is in need of appropriations to
2	purchase much needed equipment in order to carryout ongoing maintenance and operations
3	functions at the Guam Veterans Cemetery.
4	Section 2. Appropriations to the Guam Veterans Affairs Office. Notwithstanding any
5	other provision of the law, the sum of One Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred
6	Seventy Dollars and Forty Eight Cents (\$149,770.48) is reprogrammed from the Guam Highway
7	Fund to the Guam Veterans Affairs Office for the following use:
8	a. Purchase materiel to sustain cemetery maintenance efforts for Fiscal Year 2010,
9	and
10	b. Procure service to address the deficiencies which were identified in the August
11	2009 Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery Administration's
12	Triennial Report on the Guam Veterans Cemetery.
13	Section 3. Reprogramming of Appropriations within the Guam Veterans Affairs FY
14	'10 Operations Budget. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, the sum of Forty
15	Thousand Dollars is hereby transferred from Capital Outlay to Miscellaneous Appropriations
16	Class for the operations and maintenance of the Guam Veterans Cemetery as identified in the
17	August 2009 Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery Administration's Triennial
18	Report.
