AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING STIPENDS TO MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS; THROUGH AMENDING SUBSECTION C OF §3813, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that for many years members of 2 the Advisory Council on Community Health Centers have served our 3 community without any form of monetary compensation for their generous 4 service in volunteering their time, effort and commitment towards 5 ensuring that the Northern, Central, and Southern Community Health 6 Centers are adequately managed and administered in providing necessary 7 and critical healthcare services to the people of Guam who are eligible to 8 receive such services. Due to the conduct of their regular meetings in 9 different locations throughout the island, I Liheslaturan Guahan further 10 finds that the expense of transportation alone for these members could be 11 costly. Therefore, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guahan to allow for 12 minimal compensation of stipends to these advisory council members, who 13

serve our community in providing much-needed leadership in the critical
 healthcare service arena.

3 Section 2. Advisory Council of Community Health Centers, Board
4 Stipends.

Subsection "(c)" of §3813 of Chapter 3, Title 10, Guam Code
Annotated, relative to Council Compensation is hereby amended to read as
follows:

"(c) Compensation. The compensation that members of the
Advisory Council may receive shall be the compensation provided by
Guam law. Members of the Advisory Council shall be compensated Fifty
Dollars (\$50.00) per meeting, but not to exceed One Hundred Dollars
(\$100.00) per month."
