

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that for many years members of the Advisory Council on Community Health Centers have served our community without any form of monetary compensation for their generous service in volunteering their time, effort and commitment towards ensuring that the Northern, Central, and Southern Community Health Centers are adequately managed and administered in providing necessary and critical healthcare services to the people of Guam who are eligible to receive such services. Due to the conduct of their regular meetings in different locations throughout the island, I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the expense of transportation alone for these members could be costly. Therefore, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guahan to allow for minimal compensation of stipends to these advisory council members, who

1 serve our community in providing much-needed leadership in the critical

3 **Section 2. Advisory Council of Community Health Centers, Board**
4 **Stipends.**

5 Subsection "(c)" of §3813 of Chapter 3, Title 10, Guam Code
6 Annotated, relative to Council Compensation is hereby amended to read as
7 follows:

8 "(c) Compensation. ~~The compensation that members of the~~
9 ~~Advisory Council may receive shall be the compensation provided by~~
10 ~~Guam law.~~ Members of the Advisory Council shall be compensated Fifty
11 Dollars (\$50.00) per meeting, but not to exceed One Hundred Dollars
12 (\$100.00) per month."
