**AN ACT TO AMEND §7120.3 TO CHAPTER 7,
TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO THE INCLUSION OF SPOUSES,
WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS IN THE
ELIGIBILITY FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL
GOLD STAR LICENSE PLATES.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 2. A new §7120.3, Chapter 7, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
amended to read:

“§7120.3. Special Gold Star License Plates. (a) The Motor
Vehicle Division of the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall*, upon
application, issue gold star license plates. The type and style of the gold star
plates *shall* be determined by the Director of the Department of Revenue and
Taxation and the Office of Veterans Affairs, except that a gold star *shall*
appear on one (1) side of the plate. Applicants *shall* apply on forms
prescribed by the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation, and
the applicant's eligibility will be certified by the Office of Veterans Affairs.

12 The plates *shall* be re-issued *only* to the original holder of the plates. The
13 Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation *may* adopt rules to
14 implement the provisions of this Section. Except for a new *or* renewed
15 registration, applications for the issuance of gold star plates *shall* be
16 processed in the order received by the Department subject to normal
17 workflow considerations. The fee for the issuance of gold star plates *shall*
18 *not exceed* the fee charged for a similar license plate for the same class of
19 vehicle.

20 (b) Eligibility for Issuance. Gold Star License Plates *shall only* be
21 issued to parents, inclusive of mother, father, stepmother, stepfather, and
22 mother through adoption, father through adoption, and foster parents who
23 stood *in loco parentis* of members of the armed services, spouses, widows and
24 widowers.”
