AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE NINETY TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$92,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE MAYOR OF YONA FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING THE BASEBAL FIELD LIGHTS AND RENOVATING THE YONA GYM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 the lights at the Yona baseball field and the infrastructure of the Yona gymnasium 3 are in desperate need of repair and renovation and in their current state cannot be 4 utilized for their intended purpose. The lighting at the Yona baseball field is 5 6 inadequate because only half of the lights work and some of the lights need to be readjusted to fully illuminate the entire infield boundaries. The Yona gymnasium 7 is in such deteriorating state that it poses a health and safety hazard. The following 8 repairs and renovations are needed: replace the corroded tin roofing, siding and 9 exterior overhang; repair the main door, rollup windows, flooring; renovate the 10 restrooms; and finish painting the exterior walls of the gym. 11

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the people of Yona, especially the 12 youth in the village, deserve to have safe and accessible facilities. Based on cost 13 estimates from the Honorable Mayor Jose 'Pedo' Terlaje of Yona, it will cost 14 about twenty four thousand dollars (\$24,000) to repair the lights at the Yona 15 baseball field and sixty eight thousand dollars (\$68,000) to renovate the Yona 16 gymnasium. The estimated total cost is ninety-two thousand dollars (\$92,000). 17 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to appropriate the necessary 18 funding needed by the Mayor of Yona to repair the lights at the baseball field and 19 renovate the Yona gymnasium. 20

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of Ninety Two Thousand Dollars (\$92,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Mayor Of Yona for the sole purpose of repairing the lights at the Yona baseball field and renovating the Yona gymnasium in Fiscal Year 2010. Such appropriation shall not lapse and shall remain available pursuant to this act until fully expended.
