AN ACT TO REPEAL §13104 OF CHAPTER 13 OF TITLE 3, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED AND TO ADD A NEW § 1127 IN CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 2, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO VACANCIES IN I LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §13104 of Chapter 13 of Title 3, Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed.
- Section 2. A new §1127. in Chapter 1 of Title 2, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *added* to read:
- 6 "1127. Vacancies in *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. How Filled.
 - In the event of a vacancy occurring in *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* as provided herein.
 - (a) If the former member whose seat is vacant was affiliated with a major political party, the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* shall, within three
 - (3) days of the seat becoming vacant, notify in writing the chairperson of

the executive committee, or the equivalent, of the political party that the vacating member is affiliated. The party executive committee shall select three (3) party members who qualify for legislative office as nominees to fill the vacancy and submit such names in writing to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* within fifteen (15) days of receipt of notice of the vacancy. It shall be the duty of *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* to select one nominee from the names provided him to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term within fifteen (15) days of the submission thereof.

(b) If the former member whose seat is vacant was elected independent of a major political party, the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* shall, within three (3) days of the seat becoming vacant, notify in writing *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* who shall, within fifteen (15) days of notification, appoint a qualified resident to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term."
