AN ACT MAKING IT *ILLEGAL* TO POSSESS HU-210, JWH-018, JWH-073, AND SALVIA DIVINORUM OR SALVINORUM A, ALSO KNOWN AS SPICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Codification. The Compiler of Laws is hereby authorized to codify this Act within the appropriate title of the Guam Code Annotated.
- Section 2. (a) The possession of the following chemical compounds shall be illegal within the territory of Guam:
- 6 (1) (6aR,10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6,6-dimethyl-3-(2methyloctan-2-yl)-6a,7,10,10a-tetrahydrobenzo[c]chromen-1-ol, some trade or other names: HU-210.
- 9 (2) 1-Pentyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, some trade or other names: JWH-10 018.
- 11 (3) 1-Butyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, some trade or other names: JWH-12 073.
 - (4) Salvia divinorum or salvinorum A; all parts of the plant presently classified botanically as salvia divinorum, whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, any extract from any part of such plant, and every compound, manufacture, salts, derivative, mixture, or preparation of such plant, its seeds or extracts.

1 (b) A violation of subsection (a) shall be subject to the same penalties 2 and provisions contained in Chapter 67 of Title 9 of the Guam Code Annotated. 3 Severability. Section 3. If any provision of this Act or its application to 4 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity 5 shall not affect other provisions or application of this Act which can be given effect 6 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act 7 are severable.
