9 Security Forces Squadron, Guam Air National Guard; from January 2006 to  
10 present, Patrol Leader and Desk Controller, 36<sup>th</sup> Security Forces Squadron,  
11 Andersen Air Force Base (AAFB), Guam; and September 2005 to March 2006,  
12 Patrol Member, 36<sup>th</sup> Security Forces Squadron, AAFB, Guam; and

14 Morrison was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Small Arms

10 Camacho, *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*.


