1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

4 Service Recognition Week”; and

17 of the services they perform, to encourage excellence among public
18 employees, and to promote interest in civil service careers; and

22 public employees make in our daily lives; now, therefore, be it

15 Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


