4 May 10 through May 16, 2009, as a tribute to the men and women of law
5 enforcement who maintain law and order in our communities; and

6 **WHEREAS,** the brave officers of the Guam Police Department, the J. D.
7 Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority Police, the A.B. Won Pat
8 International Airport Authority Police, the Department of Agriculture
9 Conservation Officers, the Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and
10 Quarantine Officers, and the Department of Parks and Recreation Park Patrol
11 enforce the laws of our island every day, placing their lives at risk to defend
12 Guam's people and property; and

13 **WHEREAS,** with the mounting number of crimes in our community,
14 our police officers and law enforcement personnel serve long hours,
15 sacrificing their time for the welfare of others; and

16 **WHEREAS,** these courageous men and women work with the civilian
17 personnel, who perform essential functions in support of the uniformed
18 officers; and

19 **WHEREAS,** many of Guam's police, law enforcement personnel, and
20 peace officers, have lost their lives in the line of duty - the ultimate act of
21 selflessness that will be especially honored this week, and remembered all
22 year long; and


1 **WHEREAS**, the men and women of law enforcement, including those
