**Relative to recognizing and commending Rudy Stoysich
for his valiant efforts as a United States Marine in the
Pacific Campaign during World War II.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN***

1 **WHEREAS**, Rudy Stoysich was born and raised in Omaha, Nebraska.
2 Rudy and his wife, Rita, have been married for sixty-one (61) years. Together
3 they have three (3) children: Norman, Kent, and Patricia. Rudy and Rita also
4 have four (4) grandchildren. Rudy attended South High in Omaha, Nebraska;

6 **WHEREAS**, Rudy Stoysich served in the United States Marine Corps.
7 He was part of the 3rd Marine Division that landed in *Asan*, Guam, during
8 World War II. Rudy was one of the first Marines to enter *Hagatna*; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Rudy Stoysich was awarded Pacific Campaign Medals for
10 his efforts in both Guam and *Iwo Jima*; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Rudy Stoysich has continued his service to the community
12 through founding and owning his own business, "The House of Sausage," in
13 Omaha, Nebraska; now, therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
15 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Rudy Stoysich for his
16 service in the United States Marine Corps during World War II; and be it
