3 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki was born on January 9, 1924 in
4 Los Angeles, California, and is married to the former Yoshiko Tamao of
5 Tokyo, Japan. They currently reside in Jonestown, *Tamuning*, and are the
6 proud parents of four (4) children: Chris, Michael, Naomi and Miki; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki moved to Guam in 1972 from
8 Tokyo, Japan, to assist Japanese companies during the growth of Guam
9 during the 1970's and 1980's, with specific focus in the *Tumon* area; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki was the only Japanese-speaking
11 attorney in Guam in the early 1970's, and worked closely with local Guam
12 business people, †Edward M. Calvo and †Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo,
13 proprietor of the Toyota dealership at the time, assisting them in their
14 dealings with Japanese businesses; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki was very generous with his time
16 in providing legal services to island residents who were less fortunate, and his
17 daughter, Miki, remembers him accepting small gifts, such as a blanket,
18 instead of payment. Friends and family fondly remember Attorney Yokozeki
19 as being always very humble and never offensive. He assisted insurance and
20 car rental businesses with employee issues, including †Mr. Earl
21 Kloppenburg's family-owned business; and


1 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki worked on notable projects on
2 the island, including the *Oka* Towers in *Tamuning*, the *Daisei-Talofof* Golf
3 Course, known and frequented by avid golf enthusiasts as the Country Club

5 **WHEREAS**, Attorney David Yokozeki is a well-known and respected
6 attorney in Guam, and has been an avid fisherman, golfer, and bridge player.
7 His professional work ethic with his colleagues and friends has always been
8 above and beyond; now, therefore, be it


9 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
