**Relative to commending and congratulating Mr. John Cruickshank, a Senior Program Analyst for the National Science Foundation, for his advocacy for Guam and Micronesia.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**  
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John Cruickshank is the Senior Program Analyst for the  
4 Division of Research on Learning in Formal and Informal Settings (EHR/DRL)  
5 at the National Science Foundation (NSF); and

6           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John Cruickshank has been an outstanding advocate  
7 for championing outreach efforts to Guam, Micronesia and the Pacific region,  
8 with previous outreach efforts to include: the 2006 Hawaii Outreach  
9 Workshop, the 2007 Guam-Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands  
10 (CNMI) Outreach and Evaluation Workshops, and the 2008 American Samoa  
11 Outreach Workshop, and again returning to Guam to speak at the 2009  
12 Pacific Education Conference (PEC), in order to promote and educate  
13 participants on grant opportunities; and

14           **WHEREAS**, the outreach events serve as means through which the  
15 National Science Foundation (NSF) may increase the presence of Pacific  
16 Islanders in the field of science by promoting science education, research and  
17 participation as a gateway to economic and community improvement; and

18           **WHEREAS**, the outreach event on Guam during the PEC will continue  
19 building networks between NSF and the Pacific region, and among the islands  
20 that comprise the Pacific region. The NSF session scheduled during the  
21 conference will consist of presenting NSF grant opportunities to session  
22 participants; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the National Science Foundation Guam outreach event is to  
2 be held in concert with the 2009 Pacific Education Conference (PEC) on July 15  
3 to 17, 2009, at the University of Guam, Mangilao, Guam. The NSF and  
4 Guardians of Honor, LLC (GOH), will participate in the PEC as presenters  
5 and NSF support staff, respectively. The NSF-GOH team consists of NSF  
6 Senior Program Analyst Mr. John Cruickshank, GOH Program Manager Todd  
7 Stewart, and GOH Research Associate Susana Olague; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the NSF's participation in the PEC is part of an on-going  
9 series of outreach events aimed towards increasing the visibility and  
10 involvement of the six (6) United States-affiliated Pacific entities that are  
11 considered eligible for NSF grant funding – American Samoa, the  
12 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, the Republic of the  
13 Marshall Islands, the Republic of Palau and the Federated States of Micronesia  
14 (made up of the islands of Chuuk, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap); now, therefore,  
15 be it


16           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
