3 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos was born on July 16, 1960 in
4 *Tamuning*. She is the daughter of †Mr. Juan Santos Santos and Mrs. Maria
5 Manibusan Santos of *Chalan Pago*, Guam. Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos is the
6 eleventh (11th) of thirteen (13) children: seven (7) sisters: Mrs. Margaret S.
7 Aguon, Mrs. Julie S. Sablan, Mrs. Virginia S. Manley, Mrs. Marylou S. Gogo,
8 Ms. Bertha M. Santos, Mrs. Patricia S. Chargualaf, and Ms. Karen M. Santos
9 and five (5) brothers: Mr. William John M. Santos, Mr. Joe M. Santos, Mr.
10 Norbert M. Santos, Mr. Francisco M. Santos and Mr. Norman M. Santos; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos was educated in the Island's
12 public school system and graduated from George Washington High School in
13 1979; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos and Mr. Frank A. Torre, the son of
15 †Mr. Antonio Nauta Torre and Mrs. Felicidad Aguon Torre, have been blessed
16 with a daughter, Miss Felicia M. Torre; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos' career with the government
18 began at the Department of Revenue and Taxation in March 1980 as a Clerk,
19 and while employed with the Agency for Human Resources and
20 Development (AHRD), under a (CETA) Title II D Grant, Ms. Santos was
21 promoted from a Clerk Typist I to a Clerk Typist II. She proved to be a
22 remarkable woman who combines all the qualities necessary to make her a

1 topnotch employee. Ms. Santos' tireless and efficient work with the
2 Department of Revenue and Taxation warranted recognition of her work and
3 dedication and resulted in employment with the government on a full-time
4 permanent basis; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in July 1980, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos became a permanent
6 government employee as a Clerk Typist II at the Department of Revenue and
7 Taxation and transferred to the Department of Administration (DOA) under
8 the Division of Personnel Management. Her invaluable hard work while
9 employed at the Department of Administration was evident by receiving
10 Meritorious Salary Increments on September 1982, December 1986, and
11 September 1991. Ms. Santos' consistent progression through the rank and file
12 from a Clerk Typist II, a Clerk Typist III, a Word Processing Secretary I, a
13 Word Processing Secretary II, a Customer Service Representative, and
14 culminating with her current position as a Personnel Assistant II since January
15 2005, continued this pattern of outstanding services. This is further evidenced
16 by the numerous outstanding performance awards granted to Ms. Santos by a
17 number of her supervisors over the span of twenty-nine (29) years of service;

19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos' professional work ethic with
20 customers, employees, personnel officers and department heads has always
21 been above and beyond the average. She continuously demonstrated
22 efficiency in her assigned tasks, and her proficiency on the job commanded

2 guidance and assistance. Ms. Santos demonstrated, on numerous occasions,
3 her commitment to her job, ensuring completion of projects without
4 additional compensation. She is an excellent example of a truly exemplary
5 public employee; and now, therefore, be it

8 people of Guam, congratulate Ms. Sixta Rose M. Santos on her retirement and

10 outstanding Twenty-nine (29) years of service with the government of Guam
11 Department of Administration Human Resource Division and for sharing
