1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***

3 **WHEREAS, Dr. Rosa Roberto Carter is the daughter of †Jose Duenas**
4 **Roberto and †Antonia Santos Garrido Roberto. She has three (3) brothers and**

1 five (5) sisters and her husband is Dr. Lee D. Carter, a retired university
2 professor; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter graduated from George Washington High
4 School in 1950. In 1953, she received her Bachelor of Science degree from
5 Northern State University, Aberdeen, South Dakota, and she had a double
6 major in History and Elementary Education. In 1958, she completed a
7 comparative Education degree at Sydney University, Sydney, Australia; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1962, Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Master of Arts degree in
9 Guidance and Counseling from Northern Colorado University, Greeley,
10 Colorado. In 1976, Dr. Rosa Carter earned her Doctorate in Philosophy in
11 Education Supervision at Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green,
12 Ohio; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter's career as a professional leader is reflected
14 in her years as an elementary teacher for the Government of Guam; a high
15 school teacher for the Catholic Schools; an Assistant Principal at Wettengel
16 Elementary School; an Associate Professor at the University of Guam,
17 teaching English, *Chamorro*, Education, Psychology, and Test and
18 Measurement courses, and guidance and counseling classes at the graduate
19 level; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter had served in many positions at the
21 University of Guam and in many capacities before becoming President from
22 1977 to 1983; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter’s dissertation was: An Analysis of
2 Teachers’ Demographic Functional Efficiency. She has completed other
3 notable research and is the Co-Editor of Guam History: Perspectives, Vol. 1,
4 1997 and Vol. 2, 2005, University of Guam, and the Padre Palomo Park
5 Syllabus for Historic Preservation Trust in 2008; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter has many years in public and community
7 service, including involvement in Girl Scouts, American Red Cross, Guam
8 Council of Women’s Club, Soroptimist International of Guam, Association of
9 University Women, and Delta Kappa since 1978; and is the *sole* Proprietor of
10 Carter Consulting Company, Inc.; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Rosa Carter is a recipient of numerous awards, to
12 include: Distinguished Alumni Award from Northern State University;
13 Fulbright Scholarship with Sydney University; Phi Delta Kappa, Guam
14 Chapter; and Resolution No. 11-2002 of the Board of Trustees of the Guam
15 Community College, only to name a few; now, therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trenta Na*
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
18 people of Guam, recognize, commend and congratulate Dr. Rosa Roberto
