3 **WHEREAS,** Antonio “Tony” D. Juanico began his career with the United
4 States Navy in 1948, when he was employed by the naval government
5 contractor, MAS-DELCO; and

6 **WHEREAS,** when MAS-DELCO closed its operations on Guam in 1952,
7 Tony was hired as a civilian employee and continued his career as a mechanic,
8 serving both Naval Air Station, Tiyan, and Naval Station, Santa Rita, until he
9 retired in 1995, after forty-three (43) years of service; and

10 **WHEREAS,** even after he retired, Mr. Juanico still served various
11 contractors that serviced the Navy; and

12 **WHEREAS,** according to his co-workers, Tony had trained many
13 mechanic apprentices, who later became successful in their own respective
14 careers, some reaching management level; and

15 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Juanico is known also for his knowledge in various
16 specialties, his resiliency, his can-do attitude, and his application of both
17 practical and technical knowledge; and

18 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Juanico has been honored with several awards as both
19 a civilian and contract employee throughout his sixty-one (61) year
20 commitment to the island, the military, and our country. This amount of
21 dedication and loyalty to all sectors of government should be saluted; now,
22 therefore, be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
3 people of Guam, congratulate and commend Antonio "Tony" Juanico on his
