3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Bernadita “Bennet” Borja Narcis was born in Guam on
4 July 8, 1952, to Antonio and Anna Duenas Borja; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Narcis is married to Danzel Narcis, and the couple
6 reside in the village of *Yigo*. They have three (3) children and five (5)
7 grandchildren; and

8 **WHEREAS**, she graduated from George Washington High School in
9 1970, and subsequently received her degree in education from the University
10 of Guam in 1974; and

11 **WHEREAS**, she first gained employment with the Guam Department of
12 Education (DOE) and was assigned to Pedro C. Lujan Elementary School in
13 *Barrigada*. In addition to being a classroom teacher, Mrs. Narcis was a teacher
14 for the Department of Education Extended Day (D.E.E.D.) Program, and the
15 Summer Program And Community Enrichment (SPACE) Program. She also
16 assumed the role of Master Teacher for several education majors from the
17 University of Guam; and

18 **WHEREAS**, over the years, Mrs. Narcis has served Pedro C. Lujan
19 Elementary School in numerous capacities, including, as a Representative to
20 the Guam Federation of Teachers; as an Equal Employment Opportunity
21 Officer; as a Fifth (5th) Grade Student Council Advisor; and as a Member of the

1 Effective Schools Committee, the Textbook and Adoption Committee, and the
2 Accreditation Committee; and

3 **WHEREAS**, while at Pedro C. Lujan Elementary School, Mrs. Narcis
4 was an identified teacher for the Education For All Program and the Drug
5 Free School Program, and she was responsible for coordinating the Saturday
6 Scholars Program. She also oversaw the finances, and served as the Mistress
7 of Ceremonies for all the fifth (5th) grade promotional exercises; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Bennet Narcis has served the island of Guam in the
9 area of education for forty-one (41) years, thus demonstrating her
10 commitment to the well-being of the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
13 people of Guam, recognize the educational and societal contributions of Mrs.
14 Bennet Narcis; and be it further

15 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
16 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
17 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Mrs. Bennet Narcis on her

19 appreciation for her forty-one (41) years of dedicated service to the island of
20 Guam; and be it further

22 Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and


- 1 that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mrs. Bernadita “Bennet”
