3 **WHEREAS,** the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics
4 Association (AFCEA) is one of the world's premier C4I (Command, Control,

1 Communications, Computing, and Intelligence) professional societies, with
2 over thirty-three thousand (33,000) members on four (4) continents,
3 comprising one hundred thirty-five (135) different chapters in over thirty (30)

6 leaders, widely recognized for excellence, high ethical standards and the
7 quality of its events; and

8 **WHEREAS**, AFCEA is considered by top decision makers to be the pre-
9 eminent association in its field, serving as an ethical bridge between
10 government requirements and industry's capabilities, representing the top
11 government, industry, and military professionals; and

12 **WHEREAS**, AFCEA hosted their First (1st) Annual Marianas TechNet
13 that showcased premier technological tools and introduced the island to
14 innovative advancements of the future; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Marianas TechNet featured dynamic guest speakers
16 who addressed critical issues facing our island, providing an insider's
17 perspective on key military commands and a glimpse of the latest technology

20 examine the effects of militarism on safety in communities, the geopolitical
21 landscape of the United States' military industrial complex and the role of
