3 **WHEREAS,** Daniel Finoña Pereda was born in Guam on August 31,
4 1960, to †Juan Cruz Pereda and †Rosa Finoña Pereda; and

5 **WHEREAS,** Captain Daniel F. Pereda is married to Guadalupe Cruz
6 Pereda. They are currently residing in the village of *Chalan Pago*, and are the
7 proud parents of four (4) wonderful children: Deanna, Naomi, Daniel and
8 Josephine; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Daniel graduated from Guam Community College
10 Vocational High School Division in 1979, and subsequently enlisted in the
11 United States Army, serving in the 95th Charlie as Correctional Specialist, from
12 1979 to 1982; and

13 **WHEREAS,** he first gained employment with the Department of
14 Corrections on July 5, 1983, as Corrections Officer I. After fourteen (14) years
15 as a Corrections Officer I, he was promoted to Corrections Officer Supervisor I
16 as a Sergeant on March 21, 1997, and seven (7) years later was again promoted
17 to Corrections Officer Supervisor II as Lieutenant on February 7, 2004; and

18 **WHEREAS,** over the years, Captain Pereda has served with distinction,
19 becoming one of the most well known and loved corrections officers within
20 the Department of Corrections, exemplifying characteristics unlike any other;

1 **WHEREAS**, Captain Pereda is notable for his contributions, such as
2 being the Vice Chairperson and member of the Adjustment and Classification
3 Committee; a member of the Special Operations Response Team (SORT); and
4 currently as the Chairperson for the Disciplinary Hearing Board; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Captain Daniel F. Pereda has served the island of Guam in
6 the area of Corrections and Rehabilitation for twenty-six (26) years, thus
7 demonstrating his commitment to the well-being of the people of Guam and
8 the rehabilitation of inmates at the Department of Corrections; now, therefore,
9 be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
11 behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Captain Daniel
12 Finoña Pereda on his retirement from the Department of Corrections, and
