3           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was born on September 18, 1954, in  
4 *Talofofo*. Her parents are Rita Tudela and Juan B. Castro. She is married to  
5 Joseph N. Borja and is the proud mother of Barbara Jean Taijeron, Jolyn  
6 Michelle Taijeron, Joseph Michael Reyes, Jeffrey James Reyes, and Joyce Maria  
7 Reyes; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes, affectionately known as “Cindy”, is  
9 a loving grandmother to Kenny Jr., Keara Jean, Kisha Josette, Jonea Lynn  
10 (Taijeron), Kylie Jade, Heaven Marie, Jude Ryan, Evangeline Cynthia,  
11 Christopher Joseph, Christian Jay, Jade Lynn and Jadene Cynthia Reyes; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes began her professional career as a  
13 Substitute Teacher with the Department of Education from 1974 to 1976, and  
14 worked at Floral Fauna Title IV Project from 1977 to 1978; and

15           **WHEREAS**, on January 1, 1979, Jacintha Tudela Reyes began her  
16 employment with the Department of Public Health and Social Services as an  
17 Assistance Payment Worker I; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was then promoted in 1980 to the  
19 Assistance Payment Worker II position, while serving in the Aid to the  
20 Families with Dependent Children Program (AFDC), and then was later  
21 promoted as supervisor; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in 1984, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was promoted to Assistance  
2 Payment Worker III, which was later reclassified to Eligibility Specialist,  
3 making Cindy an Eligibility Specialist Supervisor in 1985; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes worked with the Division of Public  
5 Welfare , the Bureau of Management Support Services (1979), the Bureau of  
6 Economic Security (1979 to 1983), the Medically Indigent Program (1983 to  
7 1987), the Bureau of Health Care Financing (1987 to 1997) and the Bureau of  
8 Economic Security (1997 to 2009); and

9           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was detailed twice in March and  
10 July of 1991 as the Social Services Supervisor 1 for the Bureau of Economic  
11 Security, in addition to her position as an Eligibility Specialist; and

12           **WHEREAS**, in 1995, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was awarded the Supervisor  
13 of the Year and the Employee of the Year of the Department of Public Health  
14 and Social Services, validating her years of hard work and her ability to  
15 manage staff effectively; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Jacintha “Cindy” Tudela Reyes is an avid bowler, is very  
17 loyal to the Catholic Church and most especially to her family, and has  
18 assisted countless numbers of people during her thirty (30) years of service as  
19 a government of Guam employee; now, therefore, be it
