8 no schools without education professionals, no healthcare without nurses, no
9 stores without clerks, no phones without lines people, no clean streets without

11 park rangers, no safety and protection without police officers and firefighters,
12 no restaurants without servers and cooks, no balanced books without
13 accountants, no clean water without water workers, no clean and maintained
14 schools and buildings without custodians and maintenance workers, and no

4 be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
