1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Enrique “Rick” Aguon Muña was born on December
4 27, 1937, in *Hagåtña*, and grew up in *Sinajaña*. He is the son of Ignacio
5 Dydasco and Remedios Aguon Muña of *Hagåtña*. Mr. Enrique “Rick”
6 Aguon Muña is the eldest of five (5) children, and he has two (2) brothers –
7 Ignacio Aguon Muña and Edward Aguon Muña; and two (2) sisters –
8 †Josefa M. Castro and †Rosita M. Rowen; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Ms. Priscilla “Pat” San Nicolas was born on February 3,
10 1940, in *Malesso*. She is the daughter of †Joaquina San Nicolas of *Malesso*.
11 Ms. Priscilla San Nicolas is the fourth (4th) child of thirteen (13) children,
12 and she has five (5) brothers – †Albert, †Joseph, Francisco “Tommy,”
13 Gabriel and †Jesse; and seven (7) sisters – Rosa, Flora, Gertrude, Josephine,
14 Elaine, Elizabeth, and †Doris; and

15 **WHEREAS,** Rick served his country with the U.S. Navy and
16 separated in September 1962; he was a Guam police officer; he retired as a
17 Customs and Quarantine Officer in 1976; and then retired from
18 government service with the U. S. Navy Public Works in 2000; and

19 **WHEREAS,** Pat retired from the government of Guam on September
20 30, 1995, following thirty-two (32) years of service in various departments
21 and agencies; and

22 **WHEREAS,** rumor has it that Rick and Pat began their relationship
23 one August summer night in 1959. Rick and four (4) friends, all U.S. Navy

1 sailors were driving around the island and upon reaching *Malesso* decided
2 to stop by a retail store where Pat was working. While the men were
3 drinking sodas and listening to the “juke box” music, Pat immediately
4 singled out Rick from the rest of the men. Accordingly, what really caught
5 Pat’s attention was how Rick looked so neat and somewhat reserved, and
6 she noticed he was staring at her; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the story continues that days went by and Rick would
8 frequent the store by himself. Although Pat felt drawn to him, it occurred
9 to her that she did not stand a chance, considering that Rick was a “city”
10 boy and she was a “country” girl from southern Guam; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Rick and Pat’s courtship began in late August of 1959,
12 and in a matter of five (5) months they were united in the sacrament of
13 Matrimony at the *San Dimas* Church in *Malesso* on Saturday, at 7:00 a.m. on
14 January 30, 1960. They exchanged their marriage vows, and today, they
15 continue living happily ever after; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Rick A. and Pat San Nicolas Muña have been blessed
17 with five (5) children and their spouses: Enrique Jr. and Patricia; Joey and
18 Joanne; Joann; Paul; and Jeffrey and Esther. The Muña family were
19 formerly residents of *Sinajaña* since 1960, until they moved to their
20 Hyundai-*Mongmong* home in 1971; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Rick and Pat are doubly blessed with six (6)
22 grandchildren: Joleen M. and Glenn Mesa, Leanna, Carlos, Jodie, Troy and
23 Tino; and two (2) great-grandchildren: Jordan and Alana; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Enrique “Rick” A. Muña’s passion is bowling and all
2 other sports, especially football; he is the current 1st Vice President of the
3 Seniors Bowlers Golden Club; he is an active member of the Knights of
4 Columbus; and he has served as Deputy Grand Knight for the St. Jude
5 Council/Assembly; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Priscilla “Pat” San Nicolas Muña continues her
7 involvement with various charitable, religious, and voluntary community
8 service activities. She served for two (2) terms as the President of the
9 Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association; she served as the
10 President of the Young Men’s League of Guam Ladies Auxiliary for two (2)
11 years; and also served for two (2) years as the President of the
12 Confraternity of the St. Jude Parish Christian Mothers. Pat is also an active
13 member of the Pro-Life Movement of the Archdiocese of *Hagåtña*; she is a
14 member of the Guam Council of Women’s Club; and she is the immediate
15 Past Regent (2006 – 2009) of the Catholic Daughters of America #2047; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Rick and Pat Muña spend part of their time devoted to
17 caring for their grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and have shared a
18 love to travel together to different places over the years. They are devout
19 Catholics and are truly devoted in their faith and to each other; and

22 source of inspiration and encouragement to their colleagues, friends, and
