1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** young adults are the next generation of every community,
4 and Rotaract Clubs, a component of Rotary International, are all over the world
5 and seek to foster the growth and development of men and women between
6 the ages of eighteen (18) and thirty (30) by focusing on professional skills,
7 leadership, and service learning; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Rotaract stands for “Rotary in Action”, in which members
9 also participate in international service projects, in a global effort to bring peace
10 and international understanding to the world; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the week of March 13 is designated internationally as “World
12 Rotaract Week” to honor the chartering of the first club in North Carolina in
13 1968; and

14 **WHEREAS,** currently there are over seven thousand (7,000) clubs all over
15 the world, with over one hundred seventy-five thousand (175,000) members, all
16 creating young leaders in their communities and workplaces; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Rotaract Club of the Marianas, Guam’s only Rotaract
18 Club, was first chartered in 1985 and was active until 1993; the Club was then
19 re-chartered in 2007 and continues to be active today; and

20 **WHEREAS,** the Rotary Club of Guam, the Rotary Club of Northern
21 Guam, the Rotary Club of Sunrise, and the Rotary Club of *Tumon* Bay sponsor
22 this organization; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in celebration of “World Rotaract Week”, the Rotaract Club
2 of the Marianas will be hosting several events in conjunction with Rotary
3 International Activities for the week, to include: a volunteer event with the
4 Guam Animals in Need Shelter; several presentations to the sponsoring Rotary
5 Clubs in Guam; and a joint Rotary-Rotaract hike to *Pagat* Cave; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Rotaract Club of the Marianas has also engaged in
7 several community service projects over the years, including, mentorship days
8 with Island Girl Power; beach clean-ups; volunteering for the Soap Box Derby
9 for Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam; preservation of trees at *Cetti* Bay with the
10 Department of Agriculture; assisting with the upkeep of GAIN facilities; and
11 charity events hosted by the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association; and


12 **WHEREAS**, the regional community has also benefited from the
13 Rotaract Club of the Marianas, such as its International Service Project
14 “Christmas In July” with the Rotaract Club of Manila, in which Marianas
15 members worked to collect toys and clothes for donation to the pediatric
16 cancer ward in the Armed Forces of the Philippines Medical Center; and the
17 effort has expanded with the help of the Rotaract Club of Greater Louisville in
18 Kentucky; now, therefore, be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
20 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
21 people of Guam, recognize and commend the Rotaract Club of the Marianas
22 for its commitment to serving the people of Guam and the region, as it

9 *Maga'lahaen Guåhan.*


