3 **WHEREAS,** on a small island like Guam, community service
4 organizations have a real chance to make a difference and to foster goodwill
5 throughout the island in a way that is not felt anywhere else but Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS,** the *Laguna* Association of Guam was formed by local
7 families hailing from *Laguna*, a province of the Philippines, namely, the
8 Afuang, Agbada/Cahinhinan, Baldemor, Baet/Gagaring, San Agustin, Milano
9 and Guevara families, who gathered on January 17, 2000, and conducted its
10 first organizational meeting; and

11 **WHEREAS,** during the month of March 2010, the *Laguna* Association of
12 Guam will celebrate its Tenth (10th) Anniversary of promoting brotherhood
13 and friendship among all Filipinos and *Fil-Chamorros*, regardless of the
14 province of their birth; and

15 **WHEREAS,** throughout its ten (10) year history, the *Laguna* Association
16 of Guam has excelled in its mission of service to the community through
17 charitable contributions to non-profit organizations, such as the Guam *Lytico*
18 & *Bodig* Association, the American Red Cross, the American Cancer Society,
19 Alee Shelter, Catholic Social Service, and the Make-A-Wish Foundation; and

20 **WHEREAS,** taking pride in being a part of the island community, the
21 *Laguna* Association of Guam constructed and dedicated a picnic shelter,

1 complete with bar-b-que pit and shower facility, at the *Paseo de Susana* Park in
2 *Hagåtña* to the Department of Parks and Recreation; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in October 2008, the *Laguna* Association of Guam, proud of
4 its rich cultural heritage, erected and installed on the grounds of the official
5 residence of the Consul General of the Philippines in *Tamuning* a bust statue
6 of Dr. José Rizal, the Philippines' national hero, whose birthplace was
7 *Calamba, Laguna*; now, therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
9 behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate the *Laguna* Association of Guam
10 on its Tenth (10th) Anniversary, and on the induction of its new Officers, Board
11 Members and Advisors; and does further express *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'us*
12 *Ma'åse* to the *Laguna* Association of Guam for their valuable contributions and
13 commitment to the community and people of Guam; and be it further
