1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3 **WHEREAS**, Joseph Husslein has lived on Guam for over fifteen (15)
4 years, during which time, Mr. Husslein has been a successful leader in our
5 island's business community, as exemplified by his current position as the
6 President and Chief Executive Officer of Take Care Insurance, and as the
7 Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Veiovis, a medical travel facilitator;

9 **WHEREAS**, his professional advocacy for the health and well-being of
10 our community is paralleled only by his inspiring personal and active
11 involvement in numerous charitable organizations on island, including the
12 Make a Wish Foundation, the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life, and
13 Sanctuary, Inc.; and

14 **WHEREAS**, throughout his life, Mr. Husslein has led by example in
15 sending a positive message to our youth about the power of believing in
16 oneself and the lifelong difference we all can make in the lives of our youth
17 through one-on-one mentoring, as he has experienced as a former Big Brother
18 and a current board member of the Guam Chapter of the Big Brothers Big
19 Sisters Foundation; and

20 **WHEREAS**, since the age of fourteen (14) years Mr. Husslein has been
21 an avid cyclist, and he was a junior cyclist for the Tampa Bay Wheelman, and
22 throughout the years he has rode in an endless number of rides and races; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the “Little Big Ride” was founded by Mr. Husslein, based
2 on his love of cycling combined with a strong belief in the power and
3 influence of providing our youth with one-on-one mentoring, support, and
4 guidance; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the “Little Big Ride” is a three thousand two hundred forty
6 (3,240) mile cross-country cycling event supported by the Beacon Foundation,
7 with the goal to raise money and awareness for the Big Brothers Big Sisters
8 Foundation, and is scheduled to begin on September 12, 2010, and run
9 through October 14, 2010; and


10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Husslein will once again lead by example, as he will be

20 many charitable organizations and causes he has supported; and, be it further


21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on

- 2 Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.


