8 Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement officers enforce the laws
9 of our island every day, placing their lives at risk to defend our citizens;

12 our police officers and law enforcement personnel serve numerous and
13 increased hours, sacrificing their time for the welfare of others; and

14 **WHEREAS**, these courageous men and women work with the
15 civilian personnel who perform essential functions in support of the

17 **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police, law enforcement personnel, and
18 peace officers have died in the line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness
19 that will be remembered during “Police Week”; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the men and women of law enforcement, including

22 service to the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
