**Relative to recognizing and congratulating Jasper E. "Jack" Corbett, III, for his contributions to Guam's small business community, and extending a *Dangkolo na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to him upon his retirement from federal service.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**  
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Jasper E. "Jack" Corbett, III, arrived on Guam to assist with  
4 the disaster recovery efforts resulting from the devastation of the island by  
5 Typhoon Russ on December 20, 1990; and

6           **WHEREAS**, while temporarily stationed on Guam as a Construction  
7 Analyst with the Small Business Administration (SBA), Area 4 Disaster Office  
8 out of Sacramento, California, he fell in love with the island, its people and his  
9 wife-to-be Dianne; and

10           **WHEREAS**, when his disaster assignment with the SBA concluded, Jack  
11 decided to stay on Guam and become an entrepreneur as a professional scuba  
12 instructor with the Guam Tropical Dive Station beginning June 1992; and

13           **WHEREAS**, in July 1995, he decided to reunite with the SBA by taking a  
14 temporary position as a Loan Specialist with the Guam Branch office, being  
15 made responsible for the servicing and liquidation of the SBA disaster loan  
16 portfolio for Guam valued at more than Three Hundred Twenty Million  
17 Dollars (\$320,000,000); and

18           **WHEREAS**, through hard work, commitment, and dedication, in July  
19 2000, Jack was able to secure a permanent position within SBA as an  
20 Economic Development Specialist, and was tasked with marketing SBA's  
21 Guaranty Loan programs in addition to being responsible for the disaster loan  
22 portfolio; and

1           **WHEREAS**, with the downsizing of the Guam Branch office and  
2 reorganization of its staff, in March 2002, Jack was tapped to become a  
3 Business Opportunity Specialist (BOS) assigned to the Hawaii District office  
4 but stationed on Guam to aid small business concerns, and especially those  
5 interested in the contracting field; and

6           **WHEREAS**, since his assignment as a BOS, Jack has been dedicated to  
7 the interests of small business concerns, and his vigilance in finding business  
8 opportunities has resulted in a significant increase in the number of 8(a),  
9 HUBZone, Women In Business, Minority, Service Disabled Veteran-owned,  
10 and Small Disadvantaged Businesses on Guam and its neighboring islands;  
11 and

12           **WHEREAS**, on July 31, 2010, Jasper E. "Jack" Corbett, III, officially  
13 retired from the federal service; now, therefore, be it

14           **RESOLVED**, *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby  
15 recognize the numerous contributions made by Jack Corbett over the past  
16 twenty (20) years he has aided small businesses on Guam; and, be it further

17           **RESOLVED**, *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does wholeheartedly  
18 extend its congratulations to Jack Corbett for a job well done in furthering the  
19 economic development of the island through his advocacy of the many  
20 programs available from the Small Business Administration; and be it further

1           **RESOLVED**, *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of the  
2 people of Guam, extends a *Dangkolo na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* and its best wishes to  
3 Jack Corbett upon his retirement from federal service; and be it further

4           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the  
5 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
6 thereafter transmitted to Mr. Jasper E. "Jack" Corbett, III; and to the  
7 Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


