1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van was born in Saigon, Vietnam, on
4 November 21, 1950, and he is the son of Nguyen Hai Van and Nguyen Thi
5 Danh; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is married to Mach Tuyetyuan-Thi,
7 and they are the proud parents of a son, Nguyen Tuan Van; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1991, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van moved to Guam, and he
9 began a career in the culinary arts, working as a chef at Lien’s Restaurant; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1993, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van opened his own restaurant,
11 Xuan’s Restaurant in *Dededo*, a popular eatery specializing in Vietnamese and
12 Chinese cuisine; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in November 2000, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van became a
14 naturalized citizen of the United States of America, and he has embraced
15 Guam as his home, and the people of Guam as his extended family; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is affectionately known by his local
17 friends and customers as “Wind Thao”; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is a long-standing member of his
19 local parish, the Santa Barbara Catholic Church in *Dededo*; and

20 **WHEREAS**, kindness and good works are the embodiment of an
21 excellent public service spirit and high moral character; and service to the
22 community includes consistent acts of kindness and generosity to others; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van contributes consistently to charitable
2 causes, from fundraising for medical treatment to youth activities, and he has
3 given back to the community; and


4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van has often utilized his culinary
5 abilities to serve those who are less fortunate, and to help our senior citizens
6 and his local community church, the Santa Barbara Catholic Church in *Dededo*;

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van frequently demonstrates his public
9 service spirit to his family, his friends, and to his customers and the members
10 of the community around him; now, therefore, be it

11 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
13 people of Guam, congratulate and commend Mr. Nguyen Thao Van for his
14 consistent commitment to serving the community; and does further express its
15 sincere gratitude to him for his years of kindness and good works for the
16 people of Guam; and be it further

20 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


