**Relative to commending and congratulating Mrs. Loreta Rosas Sequito on her retirement after serving as a teacher for thirty (30) years in our island's school system; and to expressing our heartfelt gratitude to her for her dedication to service, and for her involvement and support as a steward in our island community.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN**  
2 **GUÅHAN:**

3           **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Loreta Rosas Sequito was born on March 23, 1951, in  
4 the Janiuay Province of Iloilo, Philippines. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs  
5 Margarito and Rita Rosas; and

6           **WHEREAS**, in 1972, Mrs. Sequito graduated from the University of San  
7 Agustin, receiving a Bachelor's Degree in Education, with a concentration in  
8 Language Arts and Social Studies. Immediately after graduation, she began  
9 teaching in Iloilo, Philippines, and three (3) years later, on July 31, 1975, she  
10 migrated to Guam to continue her teaching career; and

11           **WHEREAS**, on June 22, 1974, prior to leaving the Philippines, Mrs.  
12 Sequito married Francisco Sequito, her husband of thirty (30) years, and  
13 together they raised two (2) daughters: Francis Lou Sequito, who is married to  
14 Steve Meno; and Joeselle Sequito Diaz, who is married to Luis Diaz. Loreta  
15 Sequito is also the proud grandmother of four (4) grandchildren: Analea  
16 Meno, Aliana Meno, Nathaniel Diaz, and Noah Diaz; and she is a proud  
17 Godmother to more than twenty (20) children; and

18           **WHEREAS**, in 1980, Mrs. Sequito began her teaching career on Guam in  
19 the private school system, working as a third (3<sup>rd</sup>) grade teacher for one (1)  
20 year at Mount Carmel Catholic School in *Agat*,. In 1982, she made the move to  
21 teach in the public school system, working as an English teacher for fifteen  
22 (15) years at Oceanview High School in *Agat*; and for the next thirteen (13)

1 years, from August 1997 to September 2010, she was an English teacher at  
2 Southern High School in *Santa Rita*; and

3       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Sequito also has been an active participant and  
4 steward in the Catholic Church, serving as a member of the Legion of Mary  
5 for Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church in *Agat*; she helps to clean the Catholic  
6 Church in *Agat*, as well as Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in *Santa Rita* on a  
7 weekly basis; she makes weekly visits to the sick in the community for both  
8 the *Agat* and *Santa Rita* Churches; additionally, she prays the Rosary for  
9 families in need; and she is also an active member of her birthplace  
10 association, the Janiuay Philippines Association; and

11       **WHEREAS**, in addition to her community participation, Mrs. Sequito  
12 actively participates in school organizations, including serving as a member of  
13 the Social Committee at Southern High School; as a Senior Class Advisor for  
14 the Class of 1994 at Oceanview High School; and she is a member of the  
15 Curriculum Committee Focus Group for Accreditation at Southern High  
16 School; and

17       **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Sequito will be retiring on September 30, 2010, after  
18 which she plans to continue visiting the sick in their homes, and providing  
19 prayer services with her prayer group, the Legion of Mary; and

20       **WHEREAS**, while her commitment to teaching is unquestionable, she  
21 hopes that despite her absence her students will be inspired by her  
22 philosophy that success can be achieved through patience, perseverance, and

1 humility; and to her colleagues that she has had the pleasure of collaborating  
2 with, she will miss their companionship both professionally and personally as  
3 she bids them the best of success in all they do; now, therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on  
5 behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Mrs. Loreta Rosas  
6 Sequito on her retirement after serving as a teacher in Guam schools for thirty  
7 (30) years; does further recognize her for her invaluable contributions as a  
8 known advocate in the community; and does express *Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'us*  
9 *Ma'ase* to her for her dedication and commitment of service to our island's  
10 students; *and be it further*


11 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
