4 launched in 1988, and gained its initial accreditation in 1996; and

5           **WHEREAS,** recently, the Program was notified that the National  
6 League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc., had again given the UOG's  
7 Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program the longest accreditation period  
8 possible, which is eight (8) years; and

9           **WHEREAS,** the accreditation comes after the School of Nursing and  
10 Health Sciences worked tirelessly throughout the two (2)-year process, that  
11 included comprehensive self-study and a visit by the National League for  
12 Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. evaluators; and

13           **WHEREAS,** the University of Guam Nursing Program continues to be  
14 successful in producing quality professionals who contribute to our  
15 community by applying their high-level nursing skills obtained during their  
16 clinical experiences; now, therefore, be it

17           **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*  
18 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the  
19 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate the University of Guam School of  
20 Nursing and Health Sciences on achieving a full eight (8)-year accreditation,
