18 becoming the Assistant Superintendent of Special Education; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. May A. Camacho's countless contributions, and her

8 retirement from the Department of Education; and be it further


9 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on


