Relative to recognizing and memorializing the late Jane Sablan Aguon Lizama for her dedication and her superior performance during her thirty-four (34) years of Government Service; to expressing *Un Dângkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to her for her invaluable contributions to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam; and to further extending sincere condolences to her family.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Jane Sablan Aguon Lizama was born on July 29, 1936 in the
4 village of *Barrigada*, and she is the daughter of Vicente Losongco Aguon and
5 Juanita Taitano Sablan; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 1955, Jane A. Lizama graduated from George
7 Washington High School, and she then began her unprecedented dedication
8 to public service with the Guam Legislature on July 6, 1955, when she was
9 hired as a Clerk Stenographer I during the Third (3rd) Guam Legislature (1955-
10 1956); and

11 **WHEREAS**, on March 1, 1956, Jane Lizama was promoted to Clerk
12 Stenographer III. On January 1, 1958, during the Fourth (4th) Guam
13 Legislature (1957-1958), Jane was then promoted to Recording Secretary and
14 Journal Entry Clerk; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Jane Lizama was then reclassified to Legislative Recording
16 Secretary on April 5, 1959, and she worked in that position until the Seventh
17 (7th) Guam Legislature (1963-1964); and

18 **WHEREAS**, on January 18, 1965, Jane was hired as an Administrative
19 Secretary at the Office of the Governor; and on January 3, 1967, she went back
20 to legislative service with the Ninth (9th) Guam Legislature (1967-1968),
21 working again as the Recording Secretary; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Jane Lizama continued her superior performance
2 working in various legislative positions, including: Chief Clerk; Office
3 Administrator; Recording Secretary; Section Supervisor; Legal Officer; and
4 Recording Secretary Supervisor, from the Eleventh (11th) Guam Legislature to
5 the Twenty-Third (23rd) Guam Legislature; and

6 **WHEREAS**, because of her excellent performance in her duties, her
7 record of experience, her loyalty and dedication, and for having rendered a
8 total of thirty-four (34) years of government service, Mrs. Jane Lizama was
9 given recognition and a meritorious bonus by the Twenty-Third (23rd) Guam
10 Legislature, through a Legislative Resolution, on October 1996; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Jane Sablan Aguon Lizama retired as the Recording
12 Secretary Supervisor of the Twenty-Third (23rd) Guam Legislature, on January
13 3, 1997; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Jane's excellent performance in her duties, and her
15 extensive personal knowledge of the workings of the Legislature, especially
16 the day-to-day operations of the Legal Office, has earned the respect and
17 admiration of all in the Legislature; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the late Jane A. Lizama will be dearly missed by her
19 husband of fifty-one (51) years, Vicente Borja Lizama; her children: Bennett A.
20 Lizama, Richard and Bennett F. Lizama, Dorothy (Rena) and Conrad T.
21 Bascon, Roland A. Lizama, and Donna and Kevin R. Acosta; her
22 grandchildren: Victoria, Richard, Daleina, Sherilyn, Daryl, Anna, Derick,

1 Daniel, Dominic, Dionna, Roland Jr., Kamerine, Isabella, and Evan; her great-
2 grand children: Ryan Matthew and Aryana Therease; and her brothers,
3 sisters, cousins , family and friends; now, therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
6 people of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Jane Sablan Aguon

12 Jane Sablan Aguon Lizama; and be it further


13 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on


