4 Guam who retired on December 11, 2009, after twenty-four (24) years of
5 government service; and

7 working as a Legislative Aide for the Seventeenth (17th) Guam Legislature; and

8 **WHEREAS,** on July 20, 1983, Timmy Cordero transferred to the Port
9 Authority of Guam and worked as a Stevedore (Casual); in May 1985, he gained
10 a permanent position, working as a Clerk III; and on August 31, 1987, he was
11 promoted to Cargo Checker; and

12 **WHEREAS,** throughout his career, Timmy Cordero has received
13 numerous awards for his dedication to the Port Authority of Guam, including:
14 the Employee of the Month Award for July 1996 and December 1999; the
15 Outstanding Work Center of the Quarter for January 2000, October 2001, and
16 October 2004; and the Twenty (20) Years of Service Award in 2004; and

17 **WHEREAS,** Timmy Cordero performed his duties in a highly satisfactory
18 manner and he will be sorely missed, and all his colleagues and friends wish
19 him the best as he pursues his interests during his well deserved retirement; and

20 **WHEREAS,** through his dedication and his commitment to public
21 service, Timmy Cordero has positively impacted and contributed to the
22 efficiency of the Port Authority's operations; now, therefore, be it
