3 **WHEREAS,** Ray Mendiola Purugganan was born on January 17, 1953,
4 and he is the son of Jesusa Mendiola and Steve Purugganan. Ray currently
5 resides in the village of *Maina*, and he is married to Barbara Celestial
6 Purugganan. He is the proud father of Roland Paul, Rebecca Therese,
7 Renessa, and Reyna; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Ray Purugganan is a graduate of George Washington High
9 School in *Mangilao*. He received recognition on June 3, 1974, for his
10 outstanding performance in the GED Test; and

11 **WHEREAS,** on February 1, 1973, Ray began his professional career with
12 the government of Guam when he was hired to work as a General Helper at
13 the Department of Law; and on July 28, 1974, he transferred to work as a
14 General Helper at the Department of Labor; and

15 **WHEREAS,** on January 19, 1978, Ray again transferred and started
16 working at the Department of Public Health and Social Services as a Building
17 Custodian II. On July 1, 1980, Ray was re-classified to Maintenance Worker
18 and served in that position until he resigned on July 12, 1985, and then was
19 reinstated on July 19, 1985; and

20 **WHEREAS,** on October 1, 1985, Ray was promoted to Maintenance
21 Specialist and served in that position until he resigned on October 2, 1996. On

1 October 28, 1996, he then returned to his position as a Maintenance Specialist
2 at the Department of Public Health and Social Services; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in January 1992, Ray Purugganan received the Employee of
4 the Year Award from the Department of Public Health and Social Services;
5 and on December 1, 1997, he was promoted to Building Maintenance
6 Supervisor; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ray Purugganan has assisted a countless number of people
8 during his thirty-two (32) years of service as an employee of the government
9 of Guam; now, therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
11 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
12 people of Guam, congratulate and commend Ray M. Purugganan on his
13 retirement from the Department of Public Health and Social Services, and for
14 his accomplishments, his invaluable contributions, and his faithful
15 commitment to serving the people of Guam; and does further extend *Un*
16 *Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to him for his thirty-two (32) years of public
