3 **WHEREAS,** Imelda David Santos, lovingly known to her family,
4 friends, students and colleagues as “Mel”, was born on November 1, 1937, in
5 Sta. Rita , Pampanga , Philippines; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Imelda David Santos is a resident of *Barrigada*, where she
7 lives with her husband, Val Santos, and their daughter, Karina A. Santos; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Imelda David Santos is a graduate of St. Louis University of
9 Baguio, and the Ateneo de Manila University in the Philippines; and

10 **WHEREAS,** after receiving her Masters Degree at Rockville, Maryland,
11 Imelda David Santos began her professional career in Guam in 1967, working
12 as a teacher at St. John’s School in Upper *Tumon*, Guam; and in 1970, she was
13 chosen to be the Principal of St. John’s School; and

14 **WHEREAS,** because of her commitment to excellence in education, and
15 her relentless display of exceptional dedication, knowledge and skills as an
16 educator, the St. John’s School Lower Building, which had been reconstructed,
17 was dedicated to her in 1998, and was named the “I.D. Santos School
18 Building”; and

19 **WHEREAS,** from 2004 to 2005 , Imelda D. Santos was the Head Mistress
20 of St. John’s School, and she became the Dean of Students in 2006; and

21 **WHEREAS,** during her more than forty (40) years with St. John’s
22 School, Imelda D. Santos inspired students of all backgrounds; she had the

1 respect and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues; and she played
2 an active and useful role in the community, as well as in the School; and

3 **WHEREAS**, many of Imelda D. Santos' former students are very fond of
4 her and still keep in touch with her over the years. She is also known for her
5 generosity and her ability to remember each student of St. John's School; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout the past forty (40) years, Imelda D. Santos'
7 dedication and commitment to education has positively impacted and
8 contributed to the development, progress and success of education in Guam;
9 now, therefore, be it

10 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
11 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
12 people of Guam, recognize and congratulate Imelda David Santos on her

15 an educator; and does further extend *Un Dångkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to her

17 Guam; and be it further


18 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on


