1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, a group of fifty-three (53) high school students and their  
4 advisors from the Yamagata Prefectural, Tokai Daigaku Yamagata High  
5 School in Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and to pray  
6 for those who died during World War II; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the students visited the War in the Pacific National Park,  
8 *Gaan Point*, the *Faha* Massacre site, and the *Manenggon* Memorial Park in order  
9 to better understand the horrors of war and its effects on both the soldiers  
10 who fought it and the innocent civilians caught in its wake; and

11           **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this project will continue to be an annual  
12 trip, and that the tribute paid by these high school students will shine as an  
13 example that will encourage other students and organizations from Japan to  
14 make similar trips; and

15           **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, has been instrumental in trying  
16 to heal the wounds of World War II, and the tensions over the war between  
17 the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and it has held ceremonies  
18 and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

19           **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its President, Mr.  
20 Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and  
21 especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now,  
22 therefore, be it

1           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*  
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
3 people of Guam, highly commend and thank the Principal, Teachers and  
4 Students from Yamagata Prefectural, Tokai Daigaku Yamagata High School  
5 for visiting Guam and the World War II sites to honor those who died at those  
6 sites with their prayers and tributes; and does further extend *Un Dangkulo Na*  
7 *Si Yu'os Ma'åse* to Mr. Kensuke Haga and *U.S. Explore and Study, Inc.*, for their  
8 work on the project; and be it further


9           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
