3 **WHEREAS**, communities thrive under the dedicated leadership of
4 public servants, and being a small island community, these leaders are more
5 important on Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Maria San Nicolas Leon Guerrero, also
7 known as Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon Guerrero-Cruz, was born on
8 August 6, 1921, to Juan Guerrero and Rosa Delgado San Nicolas (*familian*
9 *Hilario*), and was called from this life on November 9, 2010; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Maria San Nicolas Leon Guerrero was
11 the first female person on Guam to be elected to serve as an Assistant
12 Commissioner (now Vice-Mayor); and

13 **WHEREAS**, from 1969 to 1977, the late Honorable Maria Delgado San
14 Nicolas Leon Guerrero served as the Assistant Commissioner of *Tamuning-*
15 *Tumon-Harmon*, where she focused on improving the lives of the youth of her
16 village; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon
18 Guerrero had also served as the first Residential Manager of *Guma' Trankilidat*,
19 holding that position for many years; and

20 **WHEREAS**, as an employee of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal
21 Authority (GHURA), the late Honorable Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon

1 Guerrero strived to help Guam residents struggling with the dream of
2 homeownership; and

3 **WHEREAS**, her public service also extended to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*,
4 where she had worked in the Offices of former Speakers, the Honorable
5 Thomas V.C. Tanaka, and the late Honorable Antonio R. Unpingco; and

6 **WHEREAS**, her dedication to this island was also felt in the religious
7 community, where she served in the Christian Mothers of *Tamuning*; and


8 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Maria Delgado San Nicolas Leon
9 Guerrero, fondly known as Auntie Mary and *Tita'n Hilario*, is survived by her
10 husband, Roman J. Cruz; she is additionally survived by her five (5) children
11 and their spouses: John William and Marsha Johnston Leon Guerrero; Charles
12 Raymond and Julie Franquez Leon Guerrero Perez; Joseph Victor and Barbara
13 (Bobbi) Perez Leon Guerrero; Carmen Lou and Chat Penaranda; and Gloria
14 Jean and Alex Santos Achivida; and she will also be missed by her seventeen
15 (17) grandchildren, and her thirteen (13) great-grandchildren; now, therefore,

21 *Tumon-Harmon*, for her many accomplishments, her invaluable contributions,


1 and her tireless dedication to serving the people of Guam; and does further
