3           **WHEREAS,** Francisco "Frank" G. Santos is the devoted husband of  
4 Leonila Balajadia Santos, and he is the proud father of three (3) children:  
5 James B. Santos, Frank B. Santos and Laverne S. Franco; and

6           **WHEREAS,** Mr. Frank Santos is originally from the village of  
7 *Hagåtña*, but moved to the village of *Sinajana* after World War II; and

8           **WHEREAS,** Mr. Frank Santos graduated from George Washington  
9 High School in 1955, and he then enlisted in the United States Navy,  
10 where he honorably served our country for twenty (20) years; and

11           **WHEREAS,** Mr. Frank Santos faithfully served and subsequently  
12 retired from the United States Navy as a Chief Boatswains Mate; and

13           **WHEREAS,** upon his retirement from the United States Navy, Mr.  
14 Frank Santos was hired by the Navy Resale System, and worked as a Navy  
15 Exchange Store Manager at the Naval Air Station in Miramar, San Diego  
16 California; and

17           **WHEREAS,** after relocating to Guam on May 26, 1974, Frank began  
18 his public service career working as a part-time Longshoreman Specialist at  
19 the Commercial Port of Guam; and on July 1976, he was promoted to a  
20 permanent position, working as the Harbor Master; and

21           **WHEREAS,** Mr. Frank Santos oversaw the Division of Harbor  
22 Master, the Division of Safety, and the Division of Security in his capacity

1 as the Harbor Master, and he also oversaw the *Agat* Marina and the  
2 *Hagåtña* Marina; and

3 **WHEREAS**, during his thirty-six (36) years of service at the Port,  
4 Francisco G. Santos had held several positions, to include serving as the  
5 Acting Operations Manager; the Acting Assistant General Manager; and  
6 the Acting General Manager; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Francisco G. Santos is the Chairman for the Pilot Review  
8 Board, and the Co-Chairman of the Area Maritime Security; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Frank Santos has received numerous awards for his  
10 dedication to the Port Authority of Guam, including: the Sick Leave Award  
11 for accumulating one thousand five hundred (1,500) hours in 1987; two  
12 thousand (2,000) hours in 1991; three thousand (3,000) hours in 1999; and  
13 three thousand five hundred (3,500) hours in 2004; the Outstanding Work  
14 Center of the Quarter in October 2008; the Good Housekeeping Work Center  
15 of the Year in 2006 and 2008; and the Service Award in October 2009; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Frank Santos will be retiring on December 10, 2010,  
17 after dedicating thirty-six (36) years to government service; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Francisco G. Santos has performed his duties in a  
19 highly satisfactory manner, and he will be sorely missed by all his colleagues  
20 and friends, who wish him the best on his retirement; now, therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
22 on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Francisco

1 G. Santos on his retirement from the Port Authority, and for his thirty-six  
2 (36) years of service to the people of Guam; and does further extend a  
3 sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to him for his invaluable  
4 contributions to the Port Authority of Guam and our island community;  
5 and be it further


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary
