Relative to commending and congratulating CTSI Logistics on the grand opening of their new thirty-eight thousand one hundred (38,100) square feet warehouse facility at the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Industrial Park; and to extending *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to them for their more than twenty (20) years of service and outstanding contributions to the people of Guam.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** CTSI Logistics first opened its doors in 1990 as
4 Consolidated Transportation Services, Inc., the freight forwarding arm of the
5 parent company, Tan Holdings, servicing Guam, the Northern Marianas, and
6 Micronesia; and CTSI provided critical services in support of the flourishing
7 garment industry on nearby Saipan, as well as the booming tuna shipment
8 industry on Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS,** in 1991, CTSI built its first warehousing facility on Guam
10 for consolidated freight service operations, focusing on freight forwarding, as
11 well as on growing businesses within the Pacific islands; and

12 **WHEREAS,** in 1995, CTSI opened an office at the Antonio B. Won Pat
13 International Airport to better serve its growing list of customers; and in 1997,
14 they became an agent for foreign shipping line, Mariana Express Lines, Ltd.
15 (MELL), and opened an office at the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port;
16 and

17 **WHEREAS,** the rapid expansion and globalization of businesses in the
18 1990s made CTSI take services to the next level, bringing on board a dynamic
19 team of information technology and logistics professionals, which helped the
20 company evolve into an integrated logistics provider; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, CTSI was transformed from a freight forwarder to
2 a complete logistics solutions provider, and changed its name to CTSI
3 Logistics; and

4 **WHEREAS**, CTSI built the first all-concrete warehouse in Guam;
5 breaking ground for the *Tamuning* Distribution Center in 2003, and formally
6 opening the warehouse in 2005, at a cost of more than Four Million Dollars
7 (\$4,000,000); and

8 **WHEREAS**, CTSI further strengthened its trucking service arm by
9 acquiring Rentacom, a local trucking company, adding more resources to the
10 thriving operations; and

11 **WHEREAS**, CTSI's operations in Guam continued to grow and expand
12 with the groundbreaking, in December of 2008, for the new Airport Facility
13 Warehouse at the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Industrial Park; and


14 **WHEREAS**, this new facility, which provides thirty-eight thousand one
15 hundred (38,100) square feet of storage, is yet another example of the
16 commitment of CTSI Logistics Guam to our island and our people; now,
17 therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
19 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
20 people of Guam, commend and congratulate CTSI Logistics Guam on the
21 opening of its new Airport Facility Warehouse at the A. B. Won Pat
22 International Airport Industrial Park; does extend best wishes to CTSI


1 Logistics Guam for its continued success; and does further *express Un*

15 and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


