3 **WHEREAS,** John P. Camacho was born on December 12, 1957, and he is
4 the son of Joaquin P. and Rosalia P. Camacho; and

5 **WHEREAS,** John P. Camacho is married to Arlene Meno Camacho, and
6 they have three (3) wonderful children: Andrea, John, Jr. and Nathan; and are
7 also blessed with three (3) adorable grandchildren: Ezekiel, Zion and Bella
8 Rose; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Camacho began his government of Guam career with
10 the Department of Revenue & Taxation in September 1981, working as a Tax
11 Auditor. Over the years, he was promoted to several positions, including:
12 Revenue Agent I, III & IV; Research Appeals Officer; and Deputy Tax
13 Commissioner. In 2003, Mr. Camacho was appointed to serve as the Deputy
14 Director of Revenue & Taxation, a position of prestige and honor. In 2008, Mr.
15 Camacho was appointed to the position of Commissioner of Banking and
16 Insurance, and during his tenure as the Commissioner of Banking and
17 Insurance, he was a dedicated leader who relentlessly aspired to improve the
