3 **WHEREAS,** in recognition of Sun Ja “Sunny” Oh Choi’s professional
4 success and community involvement and unselfish dedication to the beauty
5 industry on Guam, being focused on the public attention and recognition on the
6 achievements and contributions of the licensed cosmetologists of Guam, and
7 through this recognition, serving as an inspiration and an incentive for the island’s
8 cosmetological establishments to develop those qualities of perseverance and
9 determination that are necessary to succeed in any endeavor, with particular
10 consideration given to those cosmetologists who have a record of adherence to the
11 principles embodied in the beauty industry and who assume responsibility for
12 making a contribution to the community’s quality of life; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Sun Ja “Sunny” Oh Choi, the president of JUA Beauty
14 Distributor, LTD., who is a 1967 graduate of Junghwa Women’s Technical School
15 for Women, and who holds a cosmetology teacher’s certification from Naju

1 College in Korea, is selected to represent the U.S. National Cosmetology
2 Association in Soviet Union and Hungary as a Citizen Ambassador in 1990,
3 including participation as a Hair Competition Judge for the International Beauty
4 Shows in New York in 1991 and 1993 and in Korea in 1992, a pageant judge for
5 the Korea I.C.D. Pageant in 1990; and

6 **WHEREAS**, “Sunny”, in recognition of her important stature in the
7 cosmetology industry has achieved international awards having won the 1970
8 Honorary Certificate at the Kyung-in District Art Contest, the 2nd Prize winner of
9 the National Art Contest of the 5th Term in 1970, the Encouragement Prize at the
10 Korean Champion Selection Committee of Beauticians and dispatched to the 3rd
11 I.B.S. as a Korean delegate in 1974, the Honorary Certificate as a Korean delegate
12 dispatched to Spain for the International Art Olympic Contest in 1971; and

13 **WHEREAS**, “Sunny”, has attended the Hair World 1984 in Las Vegas,
14 Nevada, the Sebastian Coloring and Make-Up classes in 1985, the Vidal Sassoon
15 Academy Haircut in 1985, the Redken International Seminar in Hawaii in 1987,
16 the Clairol Master Color class in 1987, the Hair World Championship in
17 Rotterdam, Netherlands in 1990 and the Hair World Championship in Holland in
18 1990; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in 1989 to present, “Sunny”, has been an active education
20 consultant for Matrix; and

21 **WHEREAS**, in 1976, “Sunny”, first came to Guam and in 1978, opened her
22 initial beauty shop on Guam; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in 1989, “Sunny” utilized her remarkable energy and true
24 compassion in many endeavors, including the opening of JUA Beauty Distributor,
25 L.T.D., seeing to it that local cosmetologists, esthetician and barbers have access to
26 professional cosmetological products and supplies; and
