



Relative to recognizing the week of May 10, 2009 through May 16, 2009 as “Guam Police Week” and to honoring the brave men and women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Law Enforcement, the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police, the Department of Agriculture Conservation Officers, the Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and Quarantine Officers, and the Department of Parks and Recreation Park Patrol for protecting our island.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:**

2 **WHEREAS**, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from May 10, 2009
3 through May 16, 2009 as a tribute to the men and women of law enforcement who maintain law and
4 order in our communities; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the brave officers of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam
6 Law Enforcement, the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police, the Department
7 of Agriculture Conservation officers, the Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and Quarantine
8 officers, and the Department of Parks and Recreation Park Patrol enforce the laws of our island
9 every day, placing their lives at risk to defend our people and property; and

10 **WHEREAS**, with the mounting number of crimes in our community, our police officers and
11 law enforcement personnel serve long hours sacrificing their time for the welfare of others; and

12 **WHEREAS**, these courageous men and women work with the civilian personnel who
13 perform essential functions in support of the uniformed officers; and

1 **WHEREAS**, many of Guam’s police, law enforcement personnel, and peace officers, have
2 died in the line of duty, the ultimate act of selflessness that will be remembered this week; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the men and women of law enforcement, including those who are retired,
4 deserve public recognition for their unparalleled service to the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
6 hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize and commend the
7 men and women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Law Enforcement, the
8 A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority Police, the Department of Agriculture
9 Conservation officers, the Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and Quarantine officers, and the
10 Department of Parks and Recreation Park Patrol for their dedication, courage, service, and
11 professionalism; and be it further

12 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the
13 people of Guam, recognize the week of May 10, 2009 through May 16, 2009 as “Guam Police
14 Week” and encourages the community of Guam to celebrate, with uniformed and civilian members
15 of the Guam Police Department, the Port Authority of Guam Law Enforcement, the A.B. Won Pat
16 Guam International Airport Authority Police, the Department of Agriculture Conservation officers,
17 the Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and Quarantine officers, and the Department of Parks
18 and Recreation Park Patrol, in programs designed to encourage the adherence to law, to promote
19 public safety, and to pay tribute to the brave police officers and peace officers of Guam and the
20 nation who have given so much to preserve life and property through the fair and efficient
21 enforcement of law; and be it further

22 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Committee on Rules certify, and the
23 Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter

1 transmitted to Mr. Paul R. Suba, Chief of Guam Police Department; to Ms. Doris C. Aguero, Chief,
2 Port Authority of Guam Law Enforcement; to Mr. Patrick A. Fejeran, Chief, A.B. Won Pat Guam
3 International Airport Authority Law Enforcement; to Mr. Michael A. Reyes, Conservation Officer
4 III, Department of Agriculture Conservation Officers; to Dr. Russell Campbell, Chief
5 Anthropologist, Customs and Quarantine Plant Protection and Quarantine Officers; to Mr. Jose
6 Quinata, Acting Deputy Director, Department of Parks and Recreation Park Patrol; and to the
7 Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
